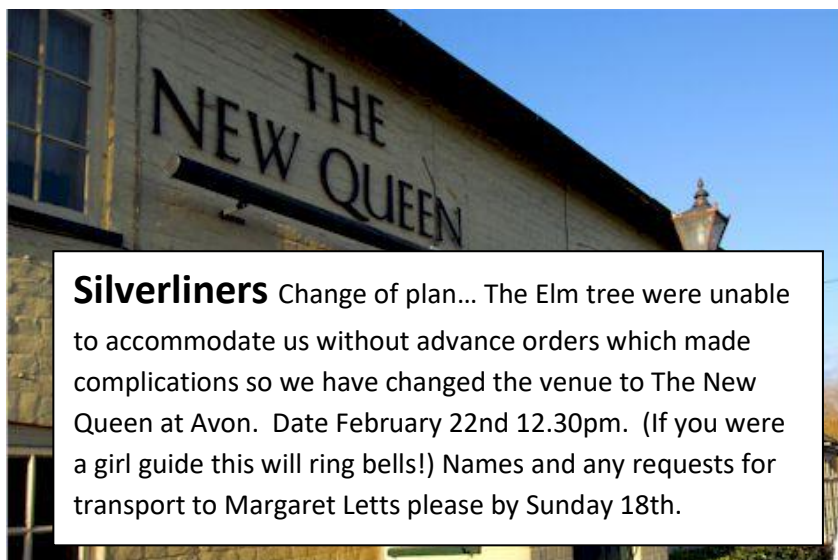

Return of the church **pub trip**: 2nd Thurs of each month at 8pm at The Crown (next one: 8th Mar)

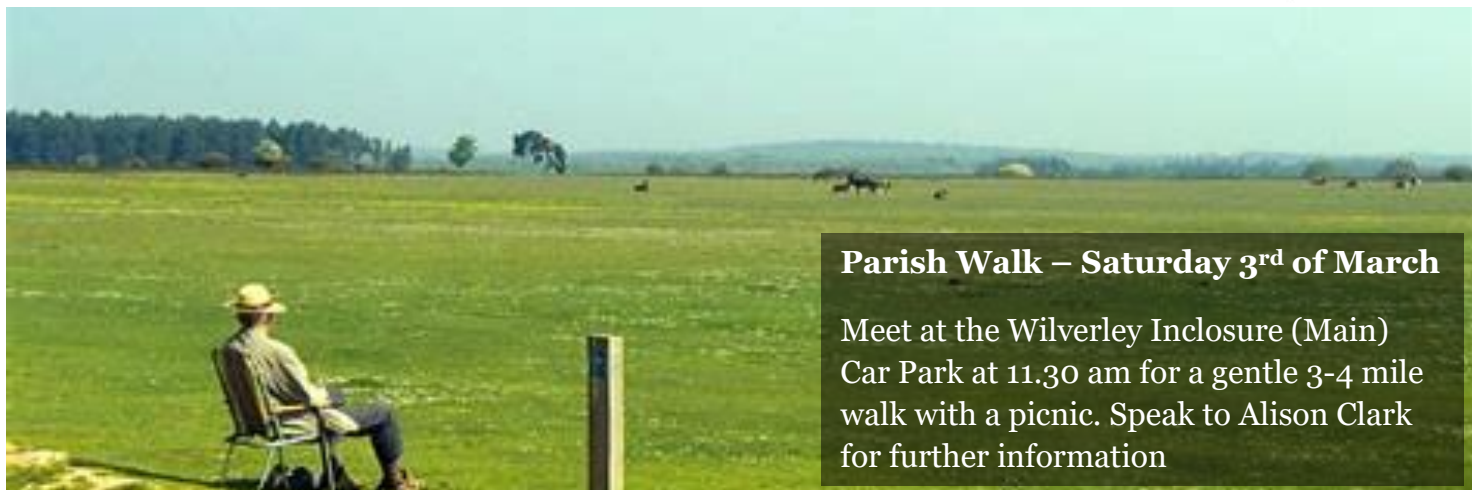
Come together in
