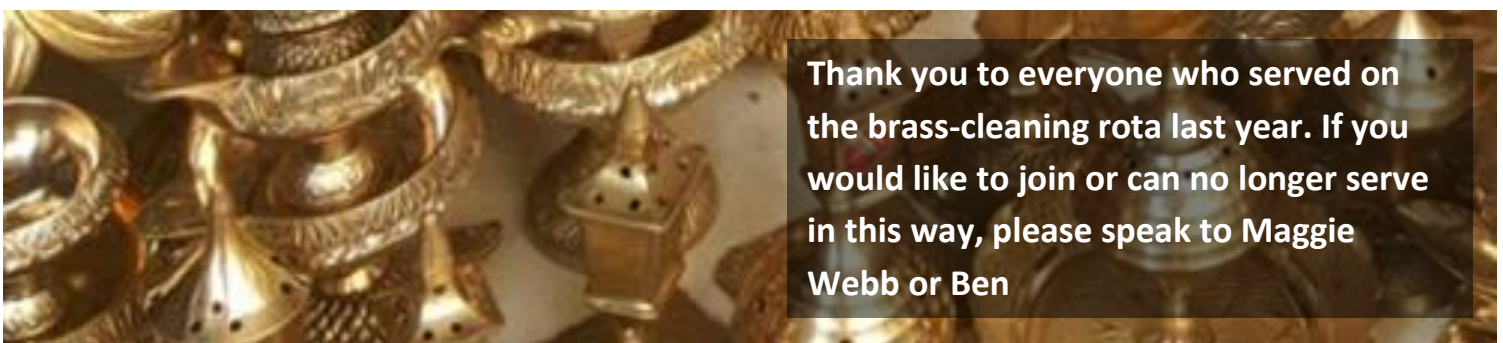
Service Teams at St Mary's this Year

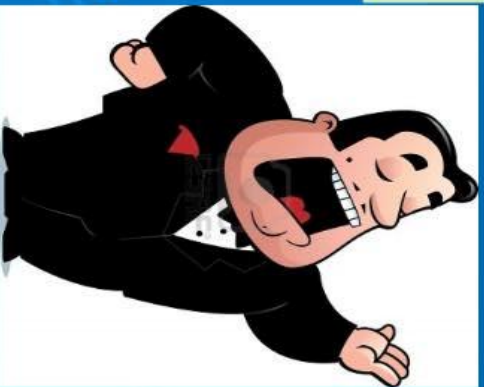

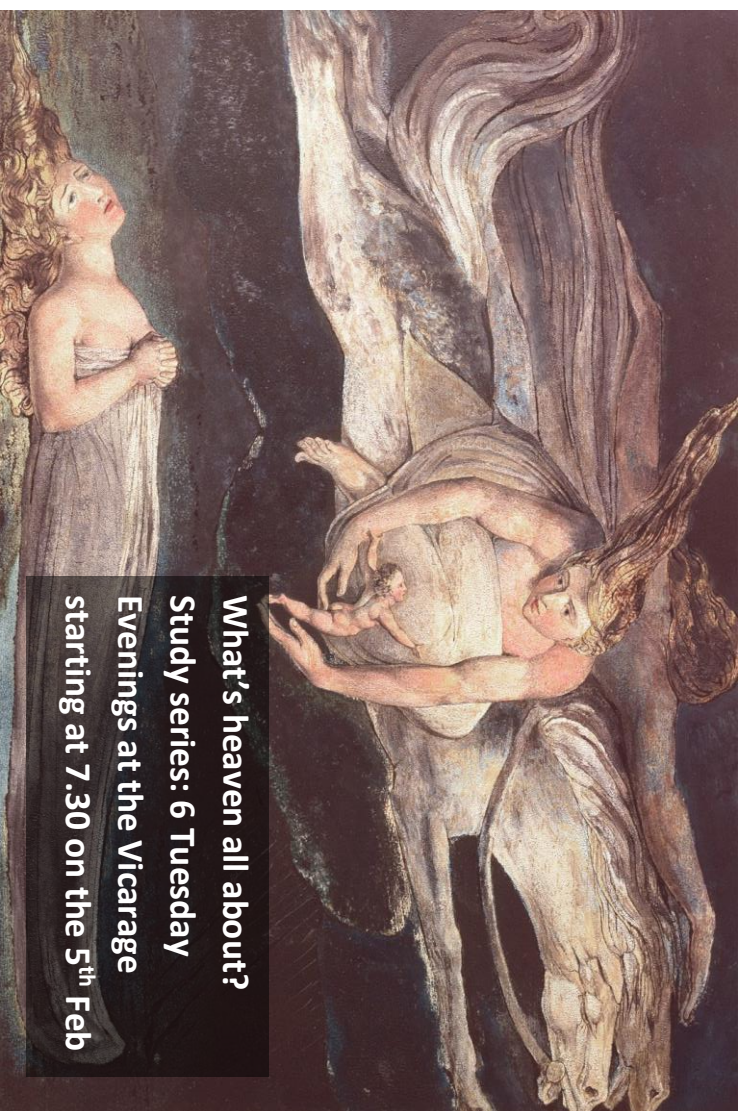
